This short brief summarizes which LanguageTrain data is created in a school context and how it fits into the TrainApps structure.

Accounts and roles

- LanguageTrain uses TrainApps accounts for learners, teachers, and organizations.
- School and organization roles are represented through shared TrainApps administration.
- Product access and classroom context remain controllable per app.

Learning features

- Vocabulary, scenarios, AI chat, notes, and history belong to the LanguageTrain learner surface.
- AI features support language practice, feedback, vocabulary work, and learning notes.
- Learners can review practice status, saved terms, and notebook entries.

School use

- Suitable as a companion brief for pilots, parent information, and internal review.
- Teachers can inspect and limit the feature areas before rollout.
- Additional agreements such as DPAs, TOMs, and school privacy rules remain separate.

Which data is product-specific?

- Language settings, level, daily goal, and practice focus
- Saved vocabulary, review status, and next due date
- AI chat sessions, chat messages, feedback, and practice duration
- Notebook entries, tags, pins, and review dates
- Local practice history for completed sessions
